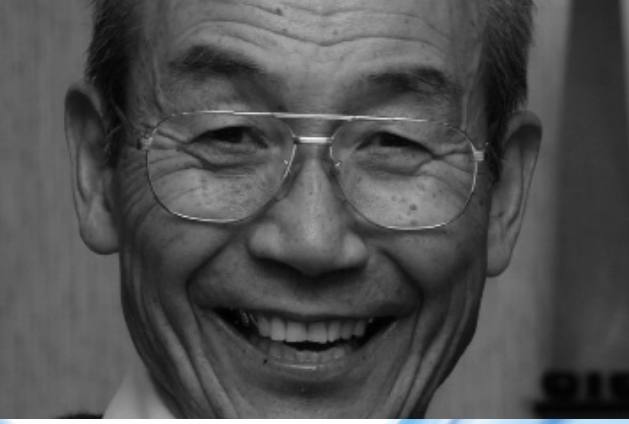

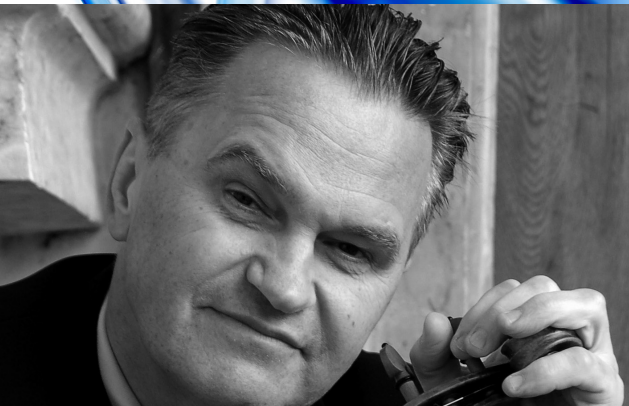
FONS TROMPENAARS

THE QUEST FOR A NEW PARADIGM

Fons Trompenaars is a renowned expert in leadership and intercultural management. After a career within Shell, the Wharton-Alumnus founded in 1989 the Centre for International Business Studies, which later became Trompenaars Hampden-Turner. His management book "Riding the Waves of Culture" was awarded "Book of the year" by the Dutch management organization OOA. Fons was mentioned one of the top 5 management consultants, next to Michael Porter, Tom Peters and Edward de Bono in a leading Business magazine in 1999.



Professor Götz W. Werner, age 67, is founder and board member of the German drugstore chain dm-drogerie markt GmbH, headquartered in Karlsruhe, where he also opened his first store in 1973. Its instant success as much as dm's continuous development led to today's prominence as one of Europe's leading brands with over 2.000 stores and approximately 35.000 employees. Already in 1976, the dm concept was transferred to Austria from where, starting in 1990, it expanded into Hungary, the Czech Republic, Slovenia, Croatia, Romania, Serbia, Bosnia, Bulgaria, and Slovakia.

His cutting edge approach and genius fuel organizational and individual development and shed new perspective on corporate strategy. 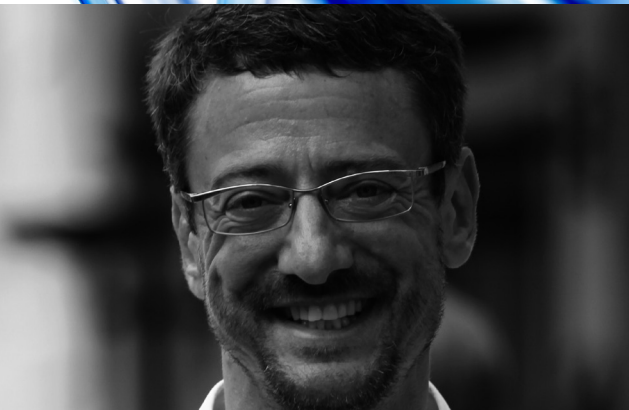
